

Child & Adolescent Health Associates will offer a Sliding Fee Discount Program to all who are unable to pay for their services, based on family size and income. Child & Adolescent Health Associates will not discriminate on the basis of age, gender, race, sexual orientation, creed, religion, disability, or national origin. No one will be denied services due to the inability to pay. The Federal Poverty Guidelines, <http://aspe.hhs.gov/poverty>, are used in creating and annually updating the sliding fee schedule (SFS) to determine eligibility.

A completed application including required documentation of the home address, household income, and insurance coverage must be on file and approved by the business office before a discount will be granted. If the applicant appears to be eligible for Medicaid, a written denial of coverage by Medicaid may also be required.

Adolescent patients seeking confidential care are exempt from the application process, and services are provided at the nominal rate.

Type of Service	Action by Child & Adolescent Health Associates
MEDICAL	The discount is applied to all in-office services supplied by Child & Adolescent Health Associates
PHARMACY	Samples are provided, when available, without charge
LAB SERVICES	The discount is applied to in-office laboratory. Reference laboratory tests and radiology tests and interpretations are excluded.
